

## Coaches Association of BC Technical Director

The Coaches Association of BC is searching for an individual to fill the new full time role of Technical Director (TD). Reporting to the Executive Director, the TD will be responsible for developing resources, partnerships, and delivering programs that will assist the organization in the on-going development of coaching throughout the province of BC.

This individual will coordinate the professional development opportunities for all of BC's NCCP Learning Facilitators (LF) to update their skills as learning facilitators and ensure that they are current on all aspects of the NCCP program. The TD will make certain that the NCCP Fundamentals Movement Skills (FMS) program is effectively delivered throughout the province in both the school and community settings, and that appropriate Learning Facilitators are trained in both of these environments to deliver this program. The CABC is developing an on-line NCCP Coach Evaluation Tool to support the certification of coaches across the province. The TD will work with participating sports in this evaluation process to ensure that their coaches can effectively access this tool, and that all participating Provincial Sport Organizations (PSO) are trained to successfully utilize this evaluation resource.

The CABC works with post secondary educational institutes to support the development of coaching degrees and coaching diploma programs in BC. The TD will work with identified colleges and universities to continue the development of post secondary coaching education. The National Coaching Institute (NCI) is a partner with the CABC in the NCCP program and the TD will work with NCI staff to coordinate and promote the delivery of the advanced coach education diploma program.

The TD will be supporting the on-going development and updating of the NCCP program through their interactions with both the Coaching Association of Canada and other provincial coaching partners. Other responsibilities will include working with national and provincial coaching partners in the development and delivery of coach professional development opportunities for maintaining coach certification, supporting Team BC's Canada Games coach initiatives, and any other duties supporting coach education and training in BC.

The TD will support the CABC's initiatives to raise the profile of coaching in the province and to support its efforts to achieve minimum coaching standards across the province.

### Qualifications:

- NCCP Level 3 certified, or Competition Development trained
- NCCP Learning Facilitator (or Course Conductor) in either multi-sport or sport specific setting with 5 years experience
- 10 years coaching experience, preferably at a provincial level
- University degree in Physical Education, or Human Kinetics, or Coaching Sciences
- Knowledge of the BC sport system
- Thorough understanding of the 'new' NCCP program
- Strong working skills in Microsoft's Office and any additional program coach education software
